

Terms and Conditions

Applicants who wish to apply for admittance must meet the following conditions:

Candidate

- The program is open to emerging and mid-career contemporary visual artists, curators and art writers from the wider Caribbean Region.
- The Art Residency is for individuals who are pursuing visual arts as their primary professional activity and may work in any field of art, including painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, film, video, digital art, and performance, or a combination of media.
- The program is designed for candidate in their early to mid-career who have earned a measure of professional recognition – in the form of exhibitions, reviews, works included in collections, awards.
- The candidate must be in a phase in which he is still growing and developing their body of work.
- The positions are open to all eligible candidates, without preference or restriction as to nationality gender, political affiliation, sexual orientation, or religious or ideological belief.
- Basic knowledge of spoken English is strongly recommended, and individual residency programs may have their own language requirements.

Application

- Applications must be made in person.
- Galleries and organizations are not eligible, and third parties cannot apply on behalf of a candidate. Art Initiative will not consider any requests from third parties concerning the application process. An engagement or contract binding the candidate to a third party will neither be an advantage nor a disadvantage for a candidate's application. Artists working together may apply as a group of up to a maximum of four persons.
- Third parties linked to the candidate have no rights of any kind, which could influence the application process of the candidate.
- Only applications made using the application forms on the Art Initiative website will be considered. No exceptions will be made.
- The application forms must be completed in English.

Selection

- Candidates for the program must complete and submit all required application materials and agree to an interview with an Art Initiative representative.
- By accomplishing the application, the candidate undersigned and declares she/he has filled in all details truthfully and accepts the General Terms and Conditions mentioned in the document.
- Once selected, participants must comply with all contractual requirements and agree to stay in the residency location for the entire duration of the residency.
- Each candidate is solely responsible for obtaining proper travel authorization; visa. will provide any required letters and necessary documentation of the program in these cases and will cover any applicable visa processing fees.
- Each candidate is solely responsible for deposit at the residency.
